For over 40 years, we have considered our patrons and our staff part of our family. We continue to uphold the highest sanitation standards. With the emergence of the Coronavirus / COVID-19 pandemic, we are taking additional measures to ensure everyone's health and safety.

We are following all local and federal government directives while our restaurants continue to serve patrons, and are taking these additional precautions:

1. **Educating Staff:** All employees have been educated in the signs and symptoms of the Coronavirus and the safeguards that can be taken to minimize the risk of contracting the virus.
2. **Increased Sanitation Guidelines:** All food-service employees are required to wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds frequently throughout the day. All food-handling staff are required to wear approved gloves when handling food product. We are disinfecting surfaces more often and extending cleaning procedures to include disinfecting all items on every table after each use. Hand sanitizer dispensers are available for our patrons.
3. **Sick Employees:** We want to minimize exposure for both our employees and our guests, and employees are being asked to stay home if they are sick.
4. **Encouraging Guests to:**
 - a. Wash your hands frequently and use a paper towel to dry.
 - b. Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
 - c. Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
 - d. Stay home when you are sick.
 - e. Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue.

We are doing everything we can to ensure the safety of our employees and patrons and will continue to monitor the situation. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.
